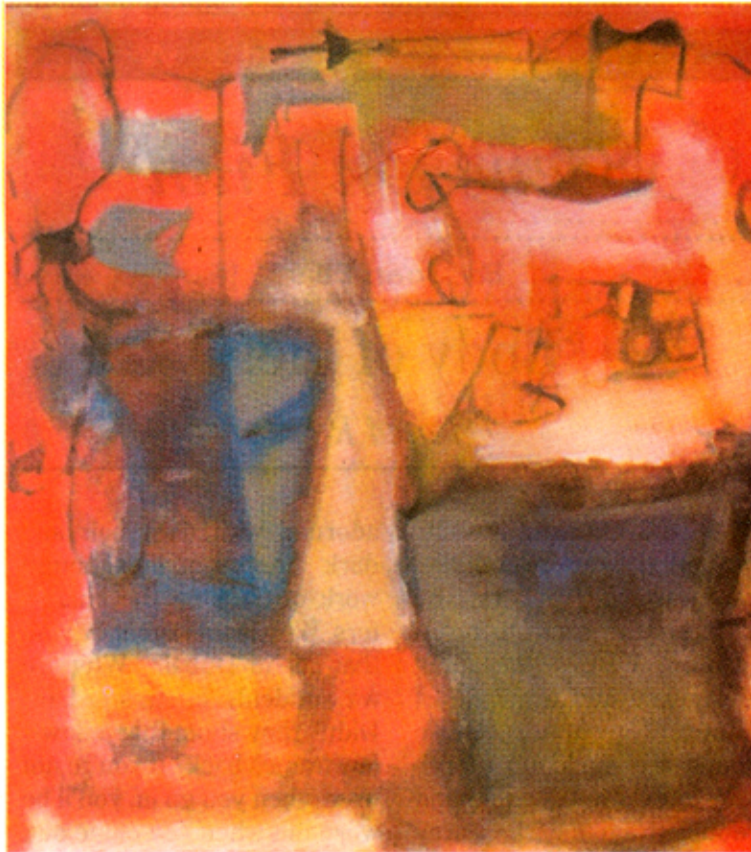
SICA JURIED EXHIBIT OPENS THIS WEEKEND
