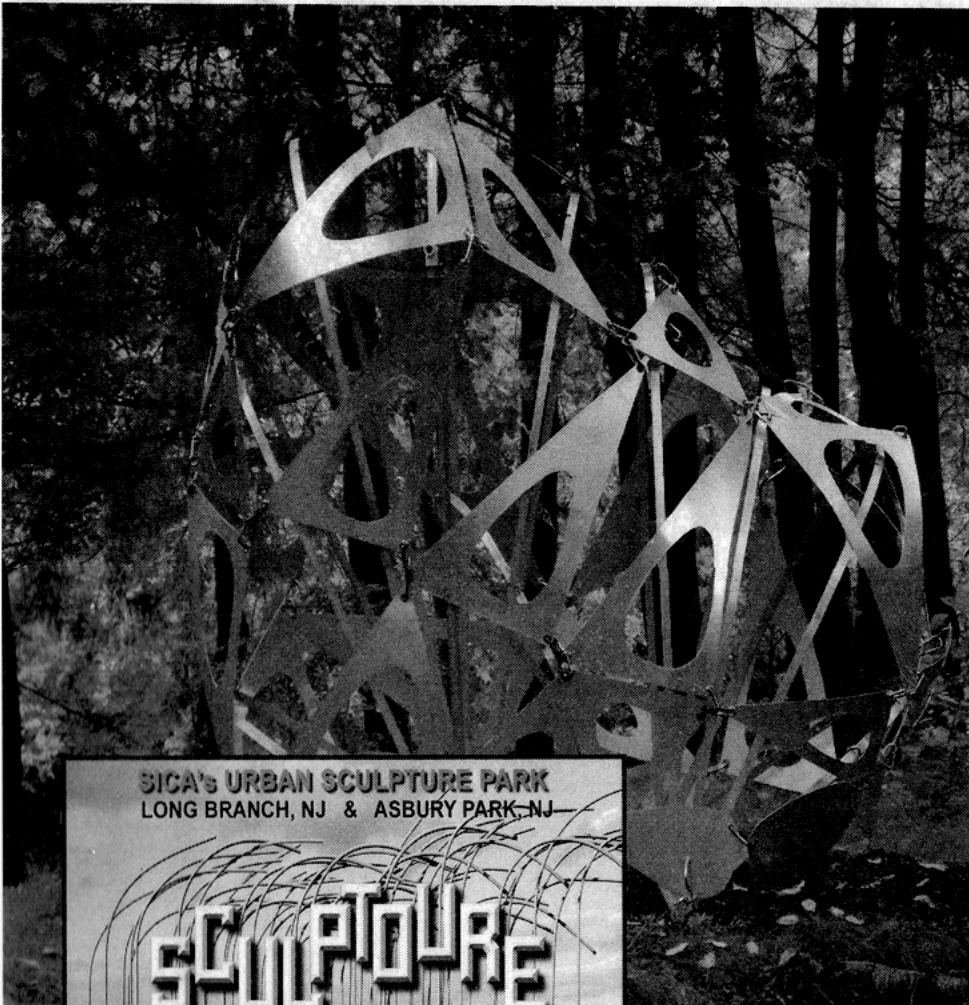


# SCULPTOURE 2011

## Long Branch & Asbury Park get the SICA treatment

The always innovative, always interesting SCULPTOURE Urban Sculpture Park installs itself in the triCities beginning this weekend.

This year SICA has joined forces with Artscap to expand beyond the borders of Long Branch. This year the five month-long sculpture display will also take place in city of Asbury Park, and will run from May 7 - September 11, 2011.

Representatives from SICA and ArtsCAP evaluated and selected the artists and the locations of the submitted works. Those artists selected to participate this year are Marah Fellicce, Kevin Karwan, Rita Payne, Chela St. Onge, Stephen Zorochin, Harry Hukkinen, Troy Knox, Michiko Rupnow, Eric Von Arx, and Harry Bower.

There is a series of events planned in Long Branch and Asbury Park for the Sunday, May 8th kick-off this year.

**12 - 2 PM Reception for HIGH RELIEF:** SICA's 5th ANNUAL NJ H.S. Sculpture Competition at SICA, 20 Third Avenue, Long Branch. This is the 5th Annual State-wide High School Sculpture Competition. This years jurors are sculptors Jordan Cohen (from Shrewsbury, NJ) and Lauren Rosenthal (from Lambertville, NJ).

**2:00 PM SCULPTOURE 2011 BEGINS IN LONG BRANCH** - We would suggest your personal "toure" begin with the sites in Long Branch located in the downtown area and in Pier Village. Sculpt"TOURE BOOKS" will be available at SICA.

**3:30 PM SCULPTOURE CONTINUES-** Continue your "toure" at the Asbury Sites. You can start at the Carousel on the boardwalk (where a video installation will also be taking place; see page 38 for details) and continue at sites at Kennedy Park and Wesley Lake.

**5 - 7 PM AFTER-TOURE PARTY AT CHICO'S HOUSE OF JAZZ** - 631 Lake Avenue, Asbury Park.
